All Sub-recipients will be required to match a minimum of 25% of the sub-grant. For example, if sub-grant is for \$10,000, Sub-recipients will be expected to expend matching funds of \$2,500. Funds cannot be used for expenses that are already earmarked for Training and Technical Assistance funds from existing DOE WAP funds managed by State agencies. All funds, including match funds, are required to be spent for the purposes of expanding training in order to provide qualified workers for completing weatherization projects funded under the DOE WAP and ARRA.
